The United States of America (“United States”) hereby seeks to apprise the Court and the persons and entities identified herein of an error in service of process and the steps it has undertaken to correct that error.

Recently, the United States started to investigate and include in this action a potentially large number of owners of new wells in the Walker River Basin. This issue was discussed generally with the Court and parties during the last status conference. Our last mailing of service packages, dated September 22, 2008 went, in error, to a large number of persons and entities

with water rights in Basin 106 who claim only domestic wells.<sup>1/</sup> Based on Paragraph 3.d. of the *Case Management Order* (Apr. 19, 2000) (“CMO”), Basin 106 does not include persons and entities with claims limited to domestic wells. We realized this error on October 3, 2008, and promptly attempted to ascertain its extent.

By this filing, we notify the Court that the persons and entities identified in the attached list do not fit within the CMO service categories and therefore should not have been served in this case.<sup>2/</sup> To date, a limited number of these persons and entities have filed waivers, appearances or disclaimers. None of these persons and entities have been included in our service reports, so we have not yet asked the Court to determine if service on them is complete.

We are mailing each person and entity on the attached list a copy of this filing, as well as a letter of explanation and apology, and have omitted their names from the case caption.
