On February 7, 2013, the Court conducted a Status Conference at which the Court heard argument on the *United States of America's Motion for a Supplemental Case Management Order and Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support*. At the conclusion on the February 7th

hearing, the Court instructed counsel for the United States to draft a proposed order that captured the Court's conclusions with respect to the motion.

Subsequently, the United States drafted a proposed Supplemental Case Management Order and circulated the proposed order for comment to the other active parties to the case. The United States' proposed order was based upon the proposed order submitted with the motion in December 2012 and the Court's instructions of February 7th. In response, the Walker River Irrigation District (WRID) proposed an alternative order to that which the United States' drafted. The proposed orders are similar in many ways. The primary difference appears to be that the United States proposes that the Magistrate Judge issue a supplemental case management order and the WRID proposed that the Court modify/amend the case management order issued in 2000.

The United States believes that the proposed Supplemental Case Management Order that it drafted remains true to the directions given by the Court on February 7th.¹ The WRID has indicated that it will submit its proposed order to the Court for its consideration. Ultimately, the Court can determine which order better captures the Court's intent. A discussion of the proposed orders is scheduled for in the agenda for the scheduled March 13, 2013 Status Conference (a copy of the proposed agenda has been filed simultaneously with this Notice).
