In addition, the United States claims surface and groundwater rights at various locations throughout the Walker River Basin on behalf of certain federal agencies, two other Indian Tribes, and numerous Indian allottees.

If you are a water rights holder in any of the above categories, have not already appeared in this matter, and wish to participate in this action or object to the United States/Walker River Tribe's claims, you are required to file, within sixty (60) days of the last publication of this Notice, a Notice of Appearance and Intent to Participate in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada.
