The Court and counsel discuss the Status Report submitted by the U.S. and the Tribe. Included in today's discussion is the topic of the documents the district had and what they were providing.


Mr. DePaoli suggests that the parties state a position on the following issues: 1) procedure for recording notices of lis pendens; 2) extent to which it is necessary to identify the counter-defendants by categories referred to in the Case Management Order and to determine the nature and extent of their water rights. The district shall file a brief on its position within 30 days; the U.S. and tribe shall file responses 30 days thereafter.

IT IS ORDERED that an **in person Status Conference is scheduled on Tuesday, March 20, 2001 at 9:00 a.m.** The district shall file a brief within 30 days and the Tribe and U.S. shall file responses 30 days thereafter. Also among the issues to be considered at the next hearing will be the Joint Motion for an Order Requiring the Identity of All Decreed Water Rights Holders and Their Successors.
