- 2. On May 30, 2001, the Court set June 11, 2001 as the date for filing responses to the Class Certification Motion, and June 29, 2001 as the date for filing replies to any responses regarding the Class Certification Motion. *Minutes of the Court* (May 30, 2001). Under the same order, the Court set July 12, 2001, as the date for argument on the Class Certification Motion. *Id*.
- 3. On June 8, 2001, the parties stipulated to extend the date for the filing of responses to the Class Certification Motion to June 18, 2001, and the date for filing replies to July 6, 2001. Stipulation and Order for Extension of Time Concerning Briefing Schedule on the Joint Motion of the United States of America and the Walker River Painte Tribe for Certification of Defendant Classes (June 8, 2001). The parties did not stipulate to change the hearing date of July 12, 2001.
- 4. The State of Nevada filed its response to the Class Certification Motion on June 13, 2001. State of Nevada's Opposition to the Joint Motion of the United States of America and the Walker River Painte Tribe for Certification of Defendant Classes (June 13, 2001). The Walker River Irrigation District filed its response on June 18, 2001. Walker River Irrigation District's Points and Authorities in Opposition to Joint Motion of the United States of America and the Walker River Painte Tribe for Certification of Defendant Classes (June 18, 2001). No other parties filed responses to the Class Certification Motion.
- 5. Also on May 30, 2001, the Court ordered the United States and the Tribe to submit a list of their methods of identification of parties by June 20, 2001, and ordered that all other parties file objections and suggestions to these methods by July 6, 2001. The Court ordered that argument on the identification methods would also be heard on July 12, 2001, in conjunction with argument on the Class Certification Motion.

- 6. On June 20, 2001, the United States and the Tribe filed their *Identification of Methods*Used by the United States of America and the Walker River Painte Tribe to Identify Persons and

  Entities to be Served Pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Case Management Order (June 20, 2001)

  ("Identification Methods").
- 7. The United States and the Tribe wish additional time in which to file their reply to the responses regarding the Class Certification Motion, and the Walker River Irrigation District wishes additional time in which to file its objections and suggestions regarding the Identification Methods.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the foregoing and subject to the approval of the Court, the parties hereby agree and stipulate that:

- 1. The United States and the Tribe shall have to and including August 3, 2001 to file their reply to the responses regarding the Class Certification Motion.
- 2. The parties shall have until August 3, 2001 to file their objections and suggestions regarding the United States' and Tribe's Identification Methods.
- 3. Oral argument regarding the Class Certification Motion and the Identification Methods shall be held on August 27, 2001, beginning at 9:30 a.m.
