(First Request)

1. On or about May 8, 2002, the United States of America ("United States") and the Walker River Paiute Tribe ("Tribe") filed a *Joint Motion of the United States of America and the Walker River Paiute Tribe For Amendment of the Court's Order Denying Motion for Certification of*

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Defendant Classes or for Relief from this Same Order and a memorandum in support thereof (“Reconsideration Motion”).

2. The Walker River Irrigation District (“District”), the State of Nevada (“Nevada”), and the U.S. Board of Water Commissioners have filed responses to the Reconsideration Motion.

3. Pursuant to Local Rule 7-2, any reply to the State’s response would be due on June 24, 2002, and any reply to the District’s and U.S. Board’s respective responses would be due on July 1, 2002.

4. The United States and the Tribe require additional time in which to serve their respective replies to these responses.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing and subject to the approval of the Court, the parties to this Stipulation and Order hereby agree and stipulate that:

The United States and the Tribe shall have to and including July 9, 2002, in which to serve their respective replies concerning the Reconsideration Motion.

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
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
