The Court hereby APPROVES the revised Notice in Lieu of Summons presented at the status conference conducted on November 27, 2007. This revision omits the requirement that persons and entities who have been personally served must mail copies of their required Notice of Appearance and Intent to Participate to the Walker River Paiute Tribe, the Walker River Irrigation District, and the States of Nevada and California. This requirement originated in Paragraph 13 of the *Case Management Order* (Apr. 19, 2000) ("CMO"), and the CMO is amended to omit this requirement.

In late 2005, this Court instituted electronic filing requirements. As a result of these new procedures, counsel for the above four entities receive copies of such filings by the electronic filing procedures. Consequently, this portion of the service requirement in Paragraph 13 of the CMO is no longer necessary. The requirement to serve counsel for the United States remains in place.

The proposed changes were provided to the parties present at the hearing, in person and on the telephone, who approved and/or had no objections to these changes.
