This Order follows the filing by the United States of America ("United States") of its *Fifteenth Report of the United States of America Concerning Status of Service on Certain Persons and Entities*, (Mar. 5, 2010) ("Fifteenth Service Report") and *Proposed Procedures to Address the Fifteenth Report of the United States of America Concerning Status of Service on Certain Persons and Entities* (Mar. 5, 2010).

The Court HEREBY ORDERS that the following procedures govern its review of the Fifteenth Service Report:

- 1. The United States has already served a copy of the Fifteenth Service Report, including exhibits, on all persons and entities receiving E-service through the Court's CMECF system.
- 2. No later than ten (10) days after the date of this Order, the United States shall serve a copy of the Fifteenth Service Report by mail on all persons and entities addressed in the Fifteenth Service Report who are <u>not</u> registered to receive E-service in this case through the Court's CMECF system, along with a copy of only those exhibits that concern their service status. The United States shall also include a copy of this Order and a copy of the Certificate of Service (*see* paragraph 3) in its service by mail. Upon request, the United States will provide any of these persons and entities with any additional exhibits they wish to obtain.
- 3. The United States shall file a Certificate of Service demonstrating its timely service by mail pursuant to Paragraph 2 of this Order.

4. Any party or other person or entity registered to receive E-service in this case through the Court's CMECF system and any person or entity whose service and/or party status is addressed in the Fifteenth Service Report shall have until <u>April 14</u>, <u>2010</u>, or thirty (30) days after the date of this Order, whichever is later, to provide any comments or corrections regarding the Fifteenth Service Report to counsel for the United States:

Parties, persons or entities providing corrections or questions to the United States may file the same with the Court, but are not required to do so.

- 5. No later than <u>April 29, 2010</u>, or forty-five (45) days after the date of this Order, whichever is later, the United States shall file a *Request for Approval of Fifteenth Report of the United States of America Concerning Status of Service on Certain Persons and Entities*("Request for Approval") that includes and addresses all comments or corrections received regarding the Fifteenth Service Report, and includes a *Proposed Order Concerning Fifteenth Report of the United States of America Concerning Status of Service on Certain Persons and Entities*. The United States shall serve this report on all parties, persons and entities described in Paragraph 1, and to any person or entity described in Paragraph 2 who submitted a comment or correction pursuant to Paragraph 4.
- 6. Following receipt of the United States' Request for Approval pursuant to the previous paragraph, the Court will determine whether to sign the *Proposed Order Concerning Fifteenth Report of the United States of America Concerning Status of Service on Certain Persons and Entities.*
