21 The Walker River Paiute Tribe (“Tribe”) hereby requests that the Court enter its order  
22 denying the motion (Doc. 2266: referred to herein as the “Suggestion of Death Notice”) to have  
23 Stanley L. Hunewill, one of the defendants herein, dismissed from this case. The request to have  
24 Mr. Hunewill dismissed states that Mr. Hunewill passed away, but it does not provide the name  
25 of the successor(s) to his interests in this case, so this case must continue with Mr. Hunewill as a  
26 party.

27 This Court’s order concerning service issues pertaining to defendants who have been  
28 served (Doc. 1650: referred to herein as the “Successor-in-Interest Order”) provides a process for  
substituting parties if a party dies. The order states if no notice or suggestion of death is made on

1 the record then the case will proceed to judgment with the original named party. Successor-in-  
2 Interest Order § II.8. “Service of a statement noting the death’ means the filing on the record in  
3 the applicable subproceeding(s) and service of a statement that identifies the successor(s) to the  
4 estate who may be substituted for the decedent.” Successor-in-Interest Order § II.9. The proper  
5 notice must include the name of the successor. The Suggestion of Death Notice filed in this  
6 subproceeding did not identify the successor to Mr. Hunewill’s estate. Therefore the case must  
7 continue with Mr. Hunewill named as a defendant.

8 Absent service of a statement noting the death in a subproceeding, the case may  
9 proceed against the original named parties in that subproceeding and will bind any  
10 and all successors-in-interest.

11 Successor-in-Interest Order § II.11.

12 Based on the foregoing, the Tribe hereby requests that the Court enter its order denying  
13 the request to have Stanley L. Hunewill dismissed from this case.
