While the parties, including the United States, may not agree on the ripeness or timeliness of each issue on this agenda, these are potential discussion points that some or all of the parties believe should be discussed to some extent.

PROPOSED AGENDA/DISCUSSION ITEMS:

General

1. Introduction of principal parties/counsel concerning Subproceeding C-125-B
2. Relationship between C-125 and Subproceedings C-125-A, C-125-B, and C-125-C

Specific Subproceeding C-125-B Discussion Points

3. Activities engaged in by the Court and parties immediately before May, 2015
 - a. Service on potentially affected parties (personal / publication)
 - b. Superseding Order regarding filing/service in Subproceeding (ECF No. 2100)
4. Remaining Potential Litigation
 - a. Water right claims asserted on behalf of the Walker River Paiute Tribe (“Tribal Claims”)
 - b. Water right claims asserted on behalf of other Indian interests and on behalf of non-Indian federal interests (“Federal Claims”)
5. Manner in which litigation would proceed under the Case Management Order (ECF No. 108) as modified by the Supplemental Case Management Order (ECF No. 1865)

6. Topics which must be addressed under paragraph 6 of the Supplemental Case Management Order (ECF No. 1865)
7. Process for updating List of Persons to Receive Postcard Notice to reflect the deletion of persons whose address has changed and who have not provided notice of an address change
8. Such additional issues that may be identified subsequent to the filing of this agenda and/or at the status conference.
9. Based upon the discussion of Agenda Items 3 through 7, determination of the next steps to be taken with respect to the remaining litigation.
10. Confirmation of next status conference and/or informal meetings.
