1. On October 30, 1992, the Court entered its order
 requiring the United States and the Walker River Paiute Tribe to
 join as parties all claimants to the waters of the Walker River

1 and its tributaries and to serve all such persons with process in
2 accordance with Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

3 2. The May 18, 1992, Scheduling and Planning Order provides
4 that:

5 Additional threshold motions in relation to
6 the counterclaim of the Tribe will be due to
7 be filed within sixty (60) days after any
8 preliminary threshold motions as provided in
9 the preceding paragraph are decided.
10 Responses to such additional threshold
11 motions will be due thirty (30) days after
12 filing and replies will be due fifteen (15)
days thereafter. This schedule shall be
subject to adjustment upon motion by the
parties and by further order of the Court if
it is determined that additional parties
should be added and service of process
required, or if additional time is needed to
give notice to any interested party in
relation to the counterclaim.

13 3. In light of the Court's October 30, 1992 order
14 concerning joinder and service of process the schedule for
15 additional threshold motions should be vacated and reestablished
16 at a scheduling conference held after the Tribe and the United
17 States have complied with the Court's October 30, 1992 order.

18 4. No prior extensions of time have been granted by the
19 Court, the Clerk of the Court or any party with respect to
20 additional threshold motions in relation to the counterclaim (now
21 cross-claims) of the Tribe and the United States.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the foregoing and subject to the
23 approval of the Court, the parties hereto, acting through their
24 respective counsel, hereby stipulate that the schedule for
25 additional threshold motions in relation to the counterclaims (now
26 cross-claims) of the Tribe and the United States be vacated and be
