(FIRST EXTENSION)

The United States of America and the Walker River Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Local Rule 150 and Rule 6(b), Fed.R.Civ.P., request an additional one hundred and twenty days (120) up to and including June 24, 1993, within which to complete joinder of additional parties and service of process on claimants to the water of the Walker River, and its tributaries, in accordance with the Order of this Court, dated October 27, 1992, (document #15).

As grounds for this request, the United States and the Tribe emphasize the magnitude of this task. There appear to be hundreds of water users in California and Nevada who claim water from the Walker River and its tributaries. The United States and the Tribe, although diligently working, have been unable to complete the task of gathering together the current names and current addresses of all water users in order to complete the required joinder and service of process under Rules 19 and 4, Fed.R.Civ.P.

The United States and the Tribe have contacted the attorneys for the Walker River Irrigation District, the U.S. Board of Water Commissioners, the State of Nevada, the California State Water Resources Control Board and California Trout, Inc. and are authorized to state that none objects to this request for enlargement of time.

WHEREFORE, the United States and the Walker River Paiute Tribe request an extension of time up to and including June 24, 1993, within which to complete the joinder of parties and service of process in this matter.




