1 The United States of America and the Walker River Paiute  
2 Tribe, pursuant to Local Rule 150, Rule 6(b), F.R.Civ.P., request  
3 additional time, up to and including May 24, 1994, within which  
4 to complete joinder of additional parties and service of process  
5 on claimants to the water of the Walker River, and its  
6 tributaries, in accordance with the Order of this Court, dated  
7 October 27, 1992, (Document No. 15).

8 The Court granted the first extension by Order dated  
9 February 23, 1993, (Document 19), and granted the second  
10 extension by Order dated June 14, 1993, (Document 20), based on a  
11 stipulation of the parties.

12 As grounds for this request, the United States and the Tribe  
13 emphasize the magnitude of this task. There appear to be  
14 hundreds of water users in California and Nevada who claim water  
15 from the Walker River and its tributaries. The United States and  
16 the Tribe, although diligently working, have been unable to  
17 complete the task of gathering together the current names and  
18 current addresses of all water users in order to complete the  
19 required joinder and service of process under Rules 19 and 4,  
20 F.R.Civ.P.

21 WHEREFORE, the United States and the Walker River Paiute  
22 Tribe request an extension of time up to and including  
23 May 24, 1994, within which to complete the joinder of parties and  
24 service of process in this matter.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the foregoing and subject to the  
26 approval of the Court, the parties hereto, acting through their  
27 respective counsel, hereby stipulate that the United States and
