Counsel for all the undersigned have stipulated to the extension.

Since the last extension some of the parties, including the United States, the Tribe and the Walker River Irrigation

District, have been exploring the possibility of a comprehensive settlement of water rights for the Walker River Basin.

Since the last extension, the United States, on July 31, 1997, filed its FIRST AMENDED COUNTERCLAIM OF THE UNITED STATES.

The Tribe also filed its FIRST AMENDED COUNTERCLAIM OF THE WALKER RIVER PAIUTE TRIBE on July 31,1997.

In addition, in Subproceeding C-125-C, it may well be determined, within the time extension herein requested, whether Mineral County is allowed to intervene in this case.

It is believed that at the present time postponement of service may be beneficial to any effort to reach a comprehensive settlement in this case.

WHEREFORE, the United States and the Walker River Paiute
