On September 8, 1998, the parties to these proceedings filed a Stipulation and Order for Extension of Time to File Responses to United States' and Walker River Paiute Tribe's Joint Motion Regarding First Amended Counterclaims (First Extension) and to Complete Service of Process (Thirteenth Extension) (Sept. 8, 1998) ("Stipulation"). The Stipulation allowed parties until November 9, 1998 to file responses to the United States' and Walker River Paiute Tribe's Joint Motion for Leave to Serve First Amended Counterclaims, To Join Groundwater Users, To Approve Forms for Notice and Waiver, and To Approve Procedure for Service of Pleadings Once the Parties are Joined (Aug. 19, 1998) ("Joint Motion"). Stipulation at 4. The Stipulation allowed the United States and the Walker River Paiute Tribe ("Tribe") to file their reply by December 9, 1998. Id. The Court entered its order approving the stipulation on September 9, 1998.

On or before November 9, 1998, the following parties filed responses to the Joint Motion: the Walker River Irrigation District; the State of Nevada; the California State Water Resources Control Board; the United States Board of Water Commissioners; and Mineral County. The parties have raised complex issues regarding the inclusion of groundwater claims in the C-125 proceedings. Further, the United States is experiencing a transition of attorneys at this time due to John Lange's retirement from the Department of Justice.

Accordingly, the parties herein stipulate and agree to modify paragraph 2 on page 4 of the Stipulation filed September 8, 1998, to provide that the United States and the Tribe have until January 22, 1999 to file their reply in support of their Joint Motion, and to respond to the *Motion for Scheduling and Planning Conference* (Nov. 9, 1998) filed by the Walker River Irrigation District, and the *Motion for More Definite Statement* (Nov. 5, 1998) filed by the State of Nevada. The Stipulation entered on September 9, 1998, is not otherwise modified.
