

materials carefully, as they are important to your legal rights and legal obligations.

There are also two Orders included herein that require you to provide certain information to the Court and the United States in two different circumstances. First, the Court anticipates use of the form attached to the ORDER – DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST in connection with the initial service upon you of the documents in this package if you have no interest in any water right within any of the nine categories of PARAGRAPH 3 of the CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER (Apr. 18, 2000). If you contend that you have been included in this litigation in error because you have no such interest, you should follow the directions in the ORDER – DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST and provide the information and documents requested. Following receipt of any DISCLAIMERS OF INTEREST IN WATER RIGHTS AND NOTICE OF RELATED INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION SUPPORTING DISCLAIMER and the accompanying information and documents, plaintiffs will review the materials received and, if appropriate, seek the Court's concurrence in omitting you from this case.

Second, the Court intends use of the form attached to the ORDER REGARDING CHANGES IN OWNERSHIP OF WATER RIGHTS for each and every sale or other conveyance of the ownership of all or a portion of any water right within any of the nine categories set forth in PARAGRAPH 3 of the CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER (Apr. 18, 2000). This Order requires you to notify the Court if you transfer any portion of your water right to another person or entity. That notice must include identification of the water right subject to the transfer, the nature of the transfer, and the name and address of the recipient of the water right. You should review this Order carefully and retain copies of it and the attached form entitled NOTICE OF CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF WATER RIGHT for your use.
