3. Holding Activity in Sub-proceedings C-125-B and C-125-C in Abeyance

The Court has stayed all activity in the C-125-B and C-125-C sub-proceedings, with the exception of efforts by the United States, Tribe and Mineral County to complete service and otherwise as ordered by the Court, through December of 2004. The parties have agreed to file a report with the Court no later than December 17, 2004, stating their respective positions as to whether the Court should extend the stay and if so for how long.

4. Payment of Mediator Fees and Expenses

The parties have agreed to file a report with the Court no later than December 17, 2004. stating their respective positions as to whether they have agreed to make and are able to make payments toward the Mediator's fees and expenses over the next six months in accordance with the provisions of the Mediation Process Agreement.

5. Need for Court Hearing

The Court has set a status conference in the C-125-B matter for December 1, 2004. There is no need for any additional hearing before the Court at the present time.
