The parties filed a stipulation on August 30, 2000 in which they agree to forms regarding service. Those forms are approved by the Court.

The parties have worked together to a great extent and have advised the USA and the tribe what information they do have concerning the various categories. The government and tribe have 60 days in which to actually obtain from each of the parties to this litigation exactly what they have so that a determination may be made as to what categories of peoples are missing who need to be identified and served.
