1 **I. INTRODUCTION**

2 On April 3, 2000, this Court entered an *Order Concerning Status of Service on*
3 *Defendants* (the "Status of Service Order") (Docket # 327). In that order, the Court identified
4 one hundred seventy (170) proposed defendants that Mineral County had either failed to serve
5 its Intervention Documents upon or the information contained in the record was insufficient to
6 establish proper service.

7 On December 18, 2001, the Court held a hearing on *Mineral County's Amended Motion*
8 *to Add and Dismiss Certain Parties* (Docket # 377). As a result, the Court entered an Order on
9 December 19, 2001, (Docket # 397) that dismissed as well as substituted several defendants
10 with respect to Mineral County's proposed intervention. In addition, the Court entered an Order
11 on December 18, 2001, (Docket # 396) that requires the District to identify the proposed
12 defendants, from the one hundred seventy (170) proposed defendants listed in the Status of
13 Service Order, that the District alleges still have not properly been served by Mineral County.


