

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On April 3, 2000, the Court filed an Order Concerning Status of Service on Defendants (Doc. #327). Among other things, that order found that Mineral County had either failed to properly serve its Intervention Documents or the information contained in the record was insufficient to establish proper service with respect to 170 proposed defendants. The order also listed the names of these 170 proposed defendants. See Doc. # 327 at 3-6.

By order dated December 18, 2001, the Court directed counsel for the Walker River Irrigation District (the "District") to identify the remaining proposed defendants, from the 170 names listed in the Order Concerning Status of Service, for which the District continued to object with respect to service by Mineral County of its Intervention Documents. Doc # 396. The District filed this list as directed by the Court on January 31, 2002. Doc. #401.

A hearing on the District's objections concerning service of Mineral County's Intervention Documents was held by the undersigned Magistrate Judge on February 25, 2002. Present in person were Dale Ferguson on behalf of the District, Linda Bowman on behalf of the United States Board of Water Commissioners and Treva Hearne on behalf of Mineral County. Present by telephone were Alice Walker on behalf of the Walker River Paiute Tribe, Susan Schneider on behalf of the United States and Michael Neville on behalf of the California Attorney General.

In addition to the rulings of the Court made at the February 25, 2002, hearing, the Court also made rulings concerning the status of service on certain proposed defendants at the status conference held on May 3, 2002. The Court has also ordered Mineral County to serve certain proposed defendants recently added or substituted into this matter.

NOW THEREFORE, based upon the written submissions and oral arguments of counsel at the February 25, 2002 hearing and rulings of the Court at the May 3, 2002, status conference, the court finds and orders as follows:
