- 5. Mineral County expects that Rule 4 service on these final four (4) Proposed
 Defendants will be complete within the next few days and is in the process of documenting final service efforts.
- 6. On Thursday, February 21, 2013, lead counsel for Mineral County, Simeon Herskovits, was hospitalized and remains in the hospital.
