The United States of America (“United States”), Plaintiff in Case No. C-125 and Subproceeding C-125-B and Defendant in Subproceeding C-125-C, moves this Court to vacate the status conference before Magistrate Judge Cobb previously scheduled for April 20, 2015 at 10:00 am. *See* Doc. ## B-2182, C-794. The paragraphs below are provided in support of this motion.

1. On February 26, 2015, the parties held a status conference before Magistrate Judge Cobb.
2. At the conclusion of the February 26th status conference, the court set the next status conference for April 20, 2015 at 10:00 AM.
3. The court instructed counsel for the United States to inquire of counsel for the principal parties whether any party believe that a status conference on April 20th was necessary. If so, counsel for the United States was instructed to prepare an agenda.
4. On April 8th, undersigned counsel circulated the draft summary from the February 26th status conference. At that time, undersigned counsel inquired of counsel for the principal parties whether anyone thought that a status conference on April 20th was necessary or whether anyone had a matter they wished to set on the agenda for an April 20th status conference.
5. No party has indicated to undersigned counsel either that they thought a status conference on April 20th was necessary or that they had a matter to set on the agenda for an April 20th status conference.
6. The United States does not believe that it is necessary to have a status conference on April 20th and has no matter to set on the Agenda.

7. The next scheduled appearance concerning the litigation associated with the Walker River Basin concerns recently filed motions to dismiss. On May 4, 2015, at 10:00 AM, the court will hear oral argument on the motions to dismiss filed in subproceeding C-125-B.
8. The next schedule status conference has been set for June 3, 2015 at 10:00 AM.

Wherefore, for the reasons articulated above, the United States requests that the court vacate the April 20th status conference.
