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COME NOW, Plaintiff-Intervenor Mineral County, Nevada, and Principal Defendants Walker River Irrigation District, Lyon County, Centennial Livestock, the Schroeder Group, Nevada Department of Wildlife, Mono County, California, Desert Pearl Farms, Peri Family Ranch, LLC, Peri & Peri LLC, and Frade Ranches ("the Parties"), by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby move the Court to reconsider its April 22, 2022, Minute Order, which denied the Parties' April 20, 2022, stipulated request to adjust the briefing schedule on Principal Defendants' October 28, 2021, Joint Motion to Dismiss Mineral County's Second Amended Complaint in Intervention Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(B)(1), 12(B)(6) and 12(B)(7) ("Motion to Dismiss"). Minute Order (April 22, 2022) (ECF 1047); see also Stipulation and [Proposed] Order Concerning Briefing Deadlines on Principal Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Mineral County's Second Amended Complaint in Intervention (April 20, 2022) (ECF 1045) ("Stipulation"); Motion to Dismiss (ECF 994, 996).

The Parties' April 20, 2022, Stipulation contained a request to adjust the response deadlines related to Principal Defendants' October 28, 2021, Motion to Dismiss as follows:

- 1. Mineral County's response to Principal Defendants' Motion to Dismiss would be due by May 31, 2022. Stipulation at 4.
- 2. Principal Defendants' joint reply in support of said joint Motion to Dismiss would be due by August 1, 2022. *Id.* at 5.

The Court's April 22, 2022, Minute Order denied the Stipulation, "because the requested extension would result in the reply brief being submitted to the Court by the end of September 2022." ECF 1047. The Minute Order further provided that "the Court will grant a brief extension so long as the joint reply brief is filed by the end of August 2022 to give the Court sufficient time to resolve the dispositive motions by the end of September 2022." Id.

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1	Because the Stipulation al	ready provides that Principal Defendants' reply brief would be
2	due by August 1, 2022, see Stipulation at 5, it already conforms to the time frame set by the	
3	Court's April 22, 2022, <i>Minute Order</i> . Accordingly, the Parties respectfully request that the	
4	Court reconsider its denial of the <i>Stipulation</i> and grant the same.
