16 Pursuant to the Order Governing Mediation Process entered herein on May 27, 2003,
17 the United States, State of Nevada, State of California, Walker River Paiute Tribe, Walker
18 River Irrigation District, Mono County, California, Lyon County, Nevada, Mineral County,
19 Nevada, and the Walker Lake Working Group (the "Parties") hereby submit the following Joint
20 Report to the Court:

22 **1. Progress in the Mediation Process**

23 The Parties have participated in monthly mediation sessions over the past six months
24 pursuant to the terms of the Mediation Process Agreement and Mediation Order. Monthly
25 mediation sessions are presently scheduled for June, 2004, and July, 2004. The Parties agree
26 that progress in the mediation process is continuing.

27 **2. Continuation of the Mediation Process**

28 The Parties agree that the mediation process should continue.

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3. Holding Activity in Sub-proceedings C-125-B and C-125-C in Abeyance

The Parties agree that all activity in the C-125-B and C-125-C sub-proceedings should continue to be stayed, with the exception of efforts by the United States, Tribe and Mineral County to complete service and otherwise as ordered by the Court.

4. Payment of Mediator Fees and Expenses

The Parties have agreed to make and are able to make payments toward the Mediator's fees and expenses over the next six months in accordance with the provisions of the Mediation Process Agreement.

5. Need for Court Hearing

There is no need for a hearing before the Court at the present time.
