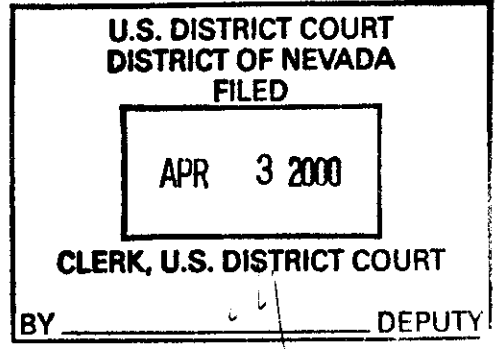

1 On August 27, 1999, the Honorable Edward C. Reed, Jr. referred this matter to the  
2 undersigned to, among other things, determine:

3 which defendants have been properly served, which defendants Mineral County  
4 has shown should be served by publication, and which defendants have not yet  
5 been correctly served but as to whom Mineral County has not yet demonstrated  
6 that service by publication is warranted.

6 Docket # 298 at 2.

7 Pursuant to that reference a conference was held on January 6, 2000. At that conference, the  
8 parties were directed to prepare:

9 2) A list of those people as to whom Walker River Irrigation District  
10 ("WRID") questions whether service is proper or has been made. WRID's  
11 objections or position with respect to why service is improper or has not been  
12 made shall be included.

12 Docket # 316 at 2. The *Walker River Irrigation District's Submission Concerning Status of*  
13 *Service on Identified and Named Defendants Pursuant to Order Dated January 6, 2000*  
14 ("WRID's Submission") was filed on February 7, 2000. Exhibit B to WRID's Submission listed  
15 the names of numerous proposed defendants identified in the caption of the *Notice in Lieu of*  
16 *Summons* issued by the Court on January 12, 1998 and for which WRID questioned whether  
17 service was proper or had been made. At a February 8, 2000 status conference a hearing was  
18 scheduled for March 14, 2000 with respect to the matters assigned by Judge Reed.

19 Present in person on March 14, 2000, were Gordon DePaoli and Dale Ferguson on  
20 behalf of WRID, Linda Bowman on behalf of the United States Board of Water  
21 Commissioners, Marta Adams on behalf of the State of Nevada, Treva Hearne on behalf of  
22 Mineral County, Alice Walker on behalf of the Walker River Paiute Tribe and Susan Schneider  
23 on behalf of the United States of America. Based upon the written submissions and oral  
24 arguments of counsel, the court finds and orders as follows:

25 1. WRID's Submission did not dispute proper service of the Intervention  
26 Documents on the proposed defendants listed in Exhibit "1" attached hereto.

1           2.       With respect to the proposed defendants listed in Exhibit B to WRID's  
2 Submission, Mineral County has properly served its Intervention Documents on the following

9 The motions to dismiss and, to the extent that substitution is required, to substitute must be  
10 properly supported and be consistent with the prior rulings of the Court in this matter.

11 5. Mineral County shall file motions requesting the Court's permission to effect  
12 service through publication on Billy Roy Beagle, Thelma G. Beagle and William Wolff. Such  
13 motions shall be consistent with the prior rulings of the Court.

14 6. The caption in this matter is hereby amended as follows:

- 15 (a) One of the two "Paul Gelles" is deleted from the caption;  
16 (b) "John R. Harveys" is deleted from the caption and "John R. Harris" is  
17 ordered substituted therefor;  
18 (c) "Mahon, Billy Frank" is hereby deleted from the caption;  
19 (d) "Craig R." is hereby deleted from the caption;  
20 (e) The caption is amended to read "Edna Jayne Sceirine" instead of "Jayne  
21 Sceirine."

22 7. Mineral County shall file and serve all motions to dismiss and substitute  
23 proposed defendants on or before August 7, 2000; responses to such motions  
24 shall be served on or before September 8, 2000 and replies in support of such  
25 motions shall be served on or before September 29, 2000.

26 8. To the extent that Mineral County intends to supplement the record to establish  
27 that proper service has been made on a proposed defendant listed in paragraph 3 above, all such  
28 supplemental information shall be filed and served on or before July 7, 2000. To the



1 extent that a party contends that the supplemental information is not adequate, written  
2 objections shall be filed and served on or before August 7, 2000; responses thereto  
3 shall be served on or before September 8, 2000; and replies in support thereof shall be  
4 served on or before September 29, 2000.

5 9. Mineral County shall file and serve motions for permission to serve by  
6 publication <sup>any</sup> ~~the~~ proposed defendants identified in paragraph 3 on or before October 31, 2000,  
7 responses to such motions shall be served on or before November 20, 2000; and replies in  
8 support of such motions shall be served on or before December 22, 2000.

9 10. To the extent that Mineral County desires to begin service of its Intervention  
10 Documents on proposed defendants identified in paragraph 3 of this order, it shall also serve  
11 the Notice in Lieu of Summons, attached hereto as Exhibit 2, properly issued by the Clerk of  
12 the Court, which Notice in Lieu of Summons includes the following provisions:

- 13 (a) Responses to Mineral County's Motion to Intervene and Mineral  
14 County's Points and Authorities in support of its Motion to Intervene  
15 shall be served pursuant to a schedule to be established by further order  
16 of the Court;
- 17 (b) No answer or other response to the proposed complaint-in-intervention  
18 will be required until a decision by the Court on Mineral County's  
19 Motion to Intervene and then only upon a schedule to be established by  
20 further order of the Court;
- 21 (c) No response to any motion for preliminary injunctive relief filed and  
22 served by Mineral County will be required until a decision by the Court  
23 on Mineral County's Motion to Intervene and then only upon a schedule  
24 to be established by further order of the Court;
- 25 (d) Within twenty (20) days of service of the Notice in Lieu of Summons the  
26 party served shall file with the Court and serve on counsel for Mineral  
27 County, the Walker River Irrigation District, the United States, Walker  
28 River Paiute Tribe, Nevada, California and the United States Board of

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Water Commissioners at their respective addresses which shall be indicated on the Notice in Lieu of Summons, a Notice of Appearance which includes the name of the party and the mailing address of that party or of its counsel;

(e) Any party who is properly served but does not file and serve a Notice of Appearance shall be deemed to have notice of subsequent orders of the Court and subsequent pleadings filed and served in this matter.

The Notice of Appearance referenced in Paragraph 10(d) shall conform to the Notice of Appearance attached hereto as Exhibit 3.
