SECOND AMENDED
SPECIAL ORDER NO. 10

Persons charged with violation in this district within the territorial jurisdiction of a United States Magistrate, of any offense listed below, whether originating under 41 CFR 101-20.3 issued under and pursuant to Public Law 566, 80th Congress, approved June 1, 1948 (40 U.S.C. 318), and the Federal Property and Administration Services Act of 1949 (63 Stat. 377) as amended, and regulations promulgated thereunder, or under applicable State statute by virtue of the Assimilated Crimes Act (18 U.S.C. 13), may, unless "Mandatory Appearance" is indicated for the particular offense, or the officer issuing the citation, at his discretion in aggravated cases, requires a personal appearance before the Magistrate, in lieu of personal appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense, waive appearance before a Magistrate and consent to forfeiture of the collateral, which forfeiture shall be equivalent to a conviction.




If a person charged with an offense fails to post and
