

12 It appearing to the Court that because of the exigency of
13 public business a work emergency did and continued to exist from
14 June 1, 1983, to and including November 30, 1983, that precluded
15 Deputy Clerk PRESTON BLUIETT, JR. from taking his annual leave as
16 heretofore scheduled. NOW, THEREFORE,

17 IT IS ORDERED that, for purposes of documentation of
18 restored leave, a work emergency be, and is hereby, declared for
19 the period June 1, 1983, to and including November 30, 1983.
20 Pursuant to Title 5, Section 6304(d)(1)(B), United States Code, all
21 accrued annual leave in excess of the maximum allowable carryover
22 (240 hours) for the 1983 leave year that has not been used by the
23 end of the 1983 leave year (January 8, 1984), and that would other-
24 wise be lost, shall be restored to Deputy Clerk PRESTON BLUIETT, JR.
25 The restored annual leave shall be used no later than the end of
26 the 1985 leave year (January 5, 1986) as provided for under Title 5,
27 Section 6304(d)(2), United States Code, and as prescribed by
