

In all appeals to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals, the original pleadings shall remain in the custody of this court and a reproduction of said pleadings, as designated, shall be transmitted to the Court of Appeals at the cost of the appellant, except when an appellant is allowed to appeal in forma pauperis in which case the clerk shall reproduce the record at no cost to the appellant.

In the event a cross appeal is filed and the clerk transmits a "joint" record the cost of reproduction shall be borne equally by both appellant and cross-appellant.
