It appearing to the Court that a special session of the United States District Court shall be held at the Elko Convention Center in Elko, Nevada, commencing July 9, 1984, it is

HEREBY ORDERED that in order to maintain courtroom security, no person, including members of various government agencies, shall be permitted to enter into the Elko Convention Center with a weapon without first obtaining the express permission of the undersigned Judge. The United States Marshal and any Deputy United States Marshal shall be exempt from this requirement; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the taking of photographs and operation of tape recorders in the Elko Convention Center or its environs and radio or television broadcasting from the interior of the Elko Convention Center or its environs during the progress of or in connection with judicial proceedings, whether or not court is actually in session, is prohibited; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that no cameras, camera equipment, nor any type of audio or visual recording or reproduction devices, nor


any other radio or television equipment shall be brought into, carried or used in any of the public areas of the Elko Convention Center during this special session of Court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that attorneys at law are exempted from the provision of the above order insofar as they shall be permitted to carry and use dictating devices except that the same shall not be used in conjunction with or during any official proceedings or in any court or hearing room within the Elko Convention Center; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that "environs" shall be defined as being all interior areas (public or private) of the Elko Convention Center; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall remain in effect from July 9, 1984, 7:00 a.m. until such time as this court shall finally adjourn said special session of court and shall have completely vacated its temporary quarters at the Elko Convention Center.
