SPECIAL ORDER NO. 82

The Federal Property Management Regulations contain policies for controlling smoking in GSA buildings. Section 101-20.105-3(a) of 41 C.F.R. Chapter 101 (1990) reflects the following considerations:

(1) In recognition of the increased health hazards of passive smoke on the non-smoker, smoking is to be held to an absolute minimum in areas where there are non-smokers.

(2) In recognition of the needs of smokers, smoking areas should be designated in Federal buildings which are convenient, do not negatively impact worker productivity, and do not impinge on the health of those who do not smoke.

(3) Agency heads are to be given the responsibility to determine which areas are to be smoking areas and which areas are to be non-smoking areas....

Section 101-20.105-3(b) of 41 C.F.R. Chapter 101 (1990) further indicates that smoking is generally prohibited in the following areas: General office areas, auditoriums, classrooms, elevators, corridors and lobbies.

The court also being aware that GSA has designated a smoking area in each of the cafeterias located in the Foley Federal Building

2 Federal Building and United States Courthouse in Reno, Nevada; and

3 The court having considered the complaints of non-smoking
4 jurors who deliberate in small, poorly ventilated rooms; and

5 The court being aware of the health hazards and fire safety
6 concerns in this matter; and


7 The court being aware that the State of Nevada has
8 eliminated smoking in many public buildings and all state buildings
9 except for designated smoking areas; now, therefore,

10 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that smoking not be permitted in the
11 United States District Court petit jury facilities located in the
12 Foley Federal Building and United States Courthouse in Las Vegas,
13 Nevada, and the C. Clifton Young Federal Building and United States
14 Courthouse in Reno, Nevada.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this policy shall become
16 effective on the filing date of this order.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is hereby
18 instructed to inform potential petit jurors of this policy.
