


On May 26, 1995, the Special Study Committee on *Pro Se* Prisoner Litigation submitted a final report to the Court containing sixteen specific recommendations. Having reviewed and discussed the recommendations of the Special Study Committee, the Court hereby formally endorses the implementation of all the recommendations of the Special Study Committee with the exception of the recommendation which suggests the "modification of the case draw to include all district judges and magistrate judges receiving an equal number of *pro se* prisoner civil rights cases." The Court is currently studying this recommendation. The Court has requested that Judge McKibben work with the committee and the Clerk of Court Lance Wilson in implementing as many of the recommendations as soon as possible.


