- Free internet access is provided at most county libraries.
- Provide an email address to receive reminders and early notification of cancellations.
- If you do not have Internet access, or someone to help you, call 775-686-5614 and leave a message stating you need help with Internet Access.

***YOU MUST CONFIRM YOUR REPORTING STATUS** after 5:00 pm on the business day prior to your reporting date:

- You may call on Friday if your reporting date falls on a Monday
- Call **775-686-5614** - You will need your "**Pool and Juror Number**" listed above.
- OR** Call **775-686-5847** - You will need your "**Participant Number**" listed above under your name/address.
- If you appear on a date that has been canceled or rescheduled you will **not be paid**.

THIS TRIAL IS EXPECTED TO LAST 2 TO 3 WEEKS. If you are not available to serve for that length of time due to scheduling conflicts (vacation, medical appointments, business commitments, school, etc.) you **MUST** request a Postponement **as soon as you receive this SUMMONS**.

Requests for Excuse or Postponements must be made (ASAP) by using one of the options below:

- **EMAIL** a request to jury_reno@nvd.uscourts.gov (type your POOL number in the subject line)
- Fax 775-686-5613 or mail your excuse request to the above address.
- **ONLY** postponement requests may be made by calling 775-686-5614. (**EMAIL is preferred as you will receive a much quicker response from the court**).


GENERAL INFORMATION

DO NOT attach a letter from your **DOCTOR** unless **SPECIFICALLY** requested by this office.

DO NOT assume your request for hardship excuse has been granted until you receive notification from the court.

PARKING is provided, and located directly across from the Courthouse; However, the **Entrance** to the garage is on **SIERRA STREET** (next to "Pegs Eggs") "PUBLIC PARKING". **You must go up the ramp** to receive your parking ticket. (maximum vehicle height is 6'7"). Bring your ticket with you for Validation. You will have to find parking if your vehicle will not fit. **DO NOT PARK AT METERS.**

HANDICAP PARKING Please call the jury office **3 business days prior to reporting** for instructions.

FAILURE TO APPEAR: Be advised, pursuant to United States Code, Title 28, Section 1866(g), "Any person summoned for jury service who fails to appear as directed shall be ordered by the district court to appear forthwith and show cause for his failure to comply with the summons. Any person who fails to show good cause for noncompliance with a summons may be fined not more than \$1000 or imprisoned not more than three days, or both."
